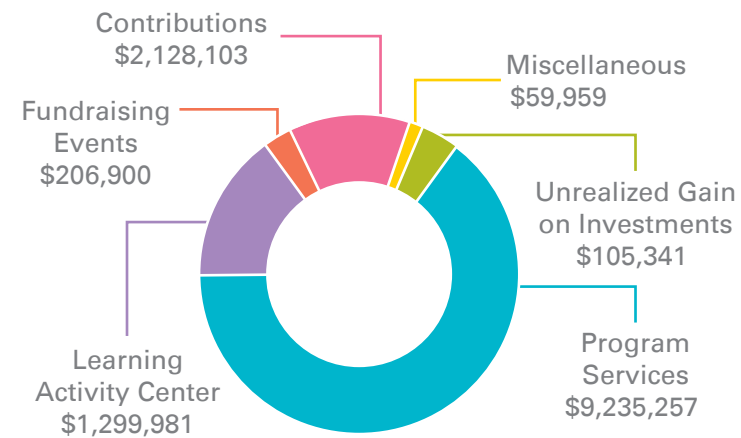
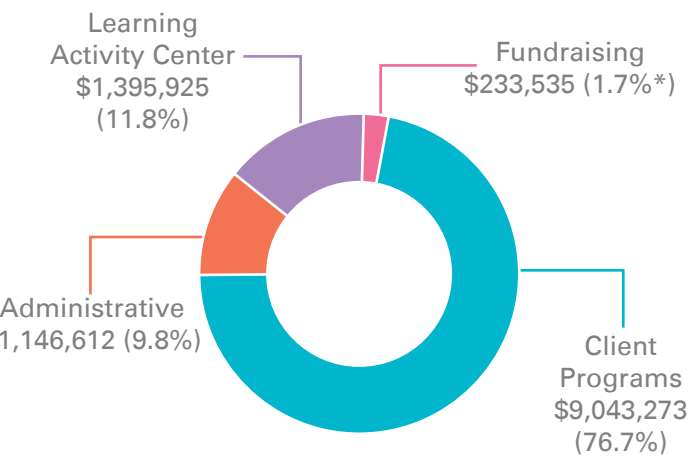

Volunteers at Reach

Volunteerism is one of the strongest components that enables Reach Unlimited to maintain service implementation and help our members continue to grow and prosper. Pre-pandemic, Reach Unlimited received more than 10,000 hours of volunteer service per year. As we have rebounded from that time, during the 2022-23 fiscal year, Reach Unlimited benefitted from 7,648 hours of volunteer service. This service flourishes throughout our programs including the Teaching Greenhouse, classroom assistants at the Learning Activity Center, our Microgreens Program, Glass Studio, Office Assistants, scouting projects/programs, philanthropy groups, corporate community days, Special Event planning and coordinating, Board of Directors and so much more.

The value of volunteer time in Texas according to the Independent Sector Report was \$29.86 per hour, meaning Reach Unlimited was gifted \$228,369.28 of time and talents of our dedicated volunteers. More than their time, Reach Unlimited volunteers have given their hearts for the benefit of our special members, staff, and the agency.

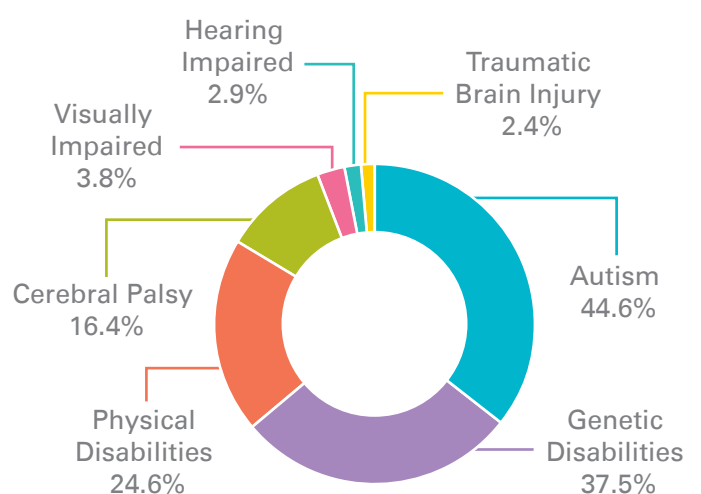
