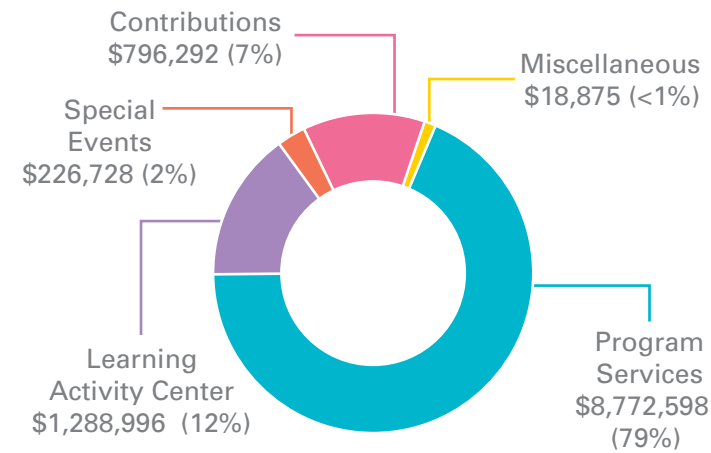
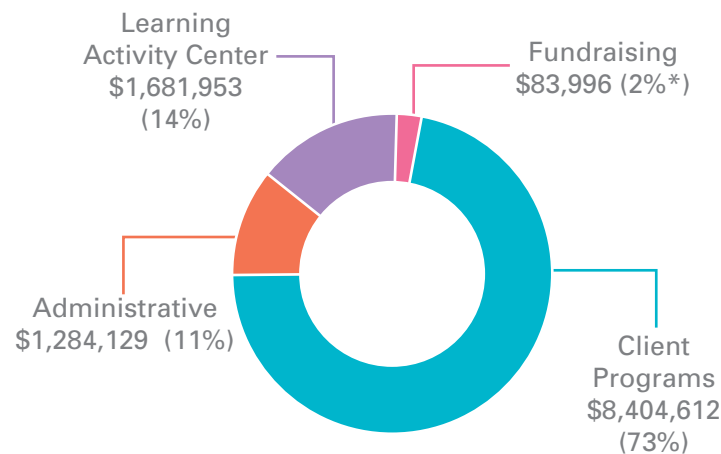

Our members have been thrilled to be back learning among their friends in the day program, working and volunteering in the community and enjoying life as we once knew it. This year permitted Reach to secure ownership of three group homes to combat inflation's influence on rent, secure funding to replace an old van with another wheelchair accessible van and move closer to the establishment of an endowment with a few generous stock donations. Looking ahead, Reach is preparing for some significant changes in the delivery of our day programming. Reach is challenged to find additional multi-passenger vehicles to safely transport our individuals into the community along with the additional staff that need to be put in place to ensure each member's safety needs are met.

A special sense of excitement is building as we enter the 40th year of Reach Unlimited providing quality support services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. We remain steadfast in our devotion to ensuring each individual grows to be as independent as possible in an environment that highlights their strengths and values their contributions. We enter this year of celebration with reflection on the dreams of the original families that brought Reach to life and what they envisioned for their children with disabilities. Through the years, we recognize those dreams held by the founding families are no different than the dreams parents hold for their children today. Every parent wants their children, regardless of their gifts and challenges, to be healthy, happy, loved, and valued.

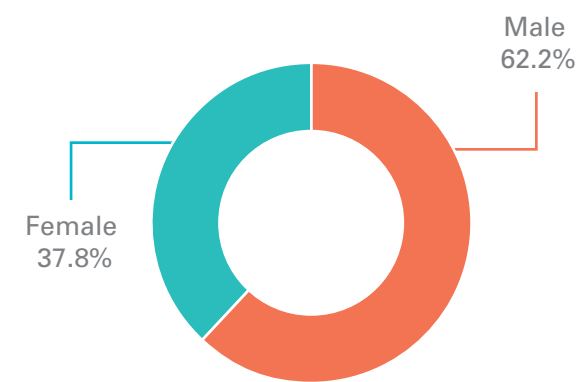

Our Mission & Vision

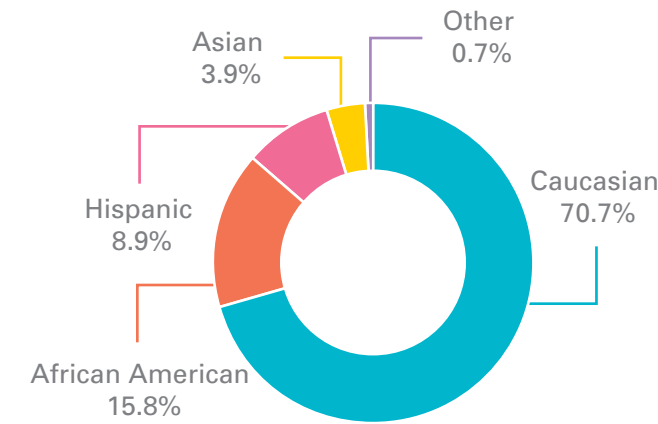

Our vision is to create a sustainable, secure environment where people with intellectual and developmental disabilities can become all they are created to be.

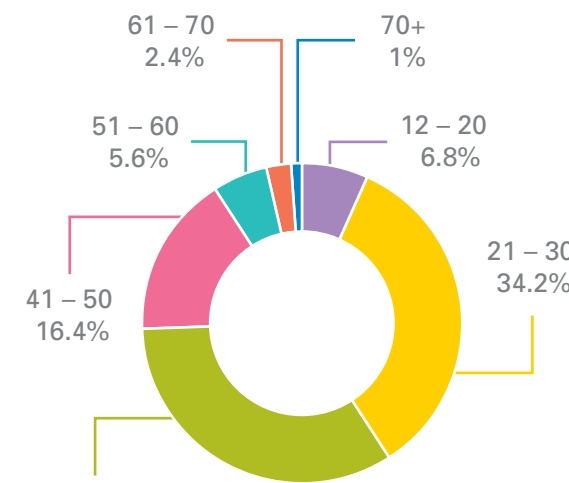

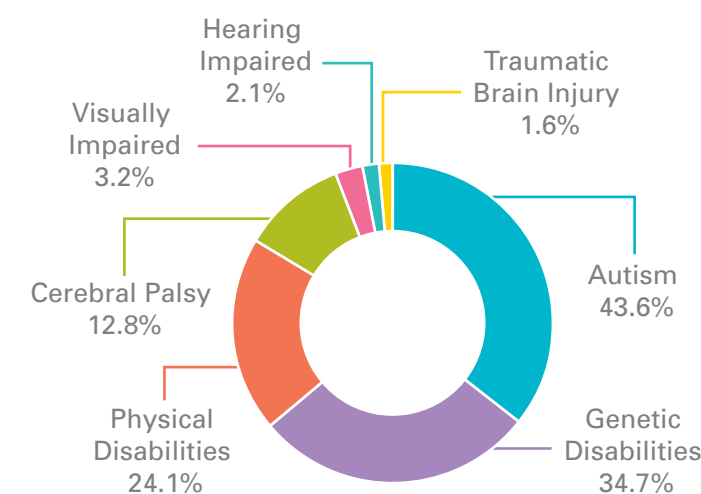
Gender
